Prior to exhibiting, offering or selling goods, ware, services, periodicals, or merchandise, or for any other commercial purpose, every licensee shall file a statement with the Board of Selectmen, under oath and the pains and penalties of perjury, indicating the average quantity and value of the goods, wares, services, periodicals, or merchandise and shall make payment to the Town of Milford in the mature of a fee equal to the taxes assessable under the last preceding tax levy. A copy of the receipt of said payment shall be presented to the Chief of Police prior to the release and issuance of said license.

The Chief of Police shall make a determination as to whether a license will be issued within twenty (20) days, and shall issue a license to approved applicants within ten (10) days, excepting Saturday, Sunday, and Legal Holidays.

The Chief of Police may deny the issuance of a license if said applicant has been convicted of a felony, or has been convicted of any one or more of the following listed misdemeanor offense, or is a fugitive from justice.

- a. assault and battery
- b. breaking and entering: entering: or breaking
- c. unlawful removal of a motor vehicle
- d. defrauding an insurer
- e. larceny
- f. shoplifting
- g. fraudulent checks
- h. unlawful or fraudulent use of credit cards
- i. unlawful taking of money or other goods
- j. stealing or poisoning a dog
- k. buying, receiving or concealing stolen goods
- I. deceptive advertising
- m. making or publishing false statements
- n. destruction or injury of a building
- o. trespass on property
- p. consumer protection
- q. firearms or weapons violations
- r. violations of the controlled substance laws

The license will be valid for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of issuance. If the expiration date is a Saturday or Sunday, the expiration date will be the Monday post. If the expiration date is a legal holiday, the expiration date will be the next calendar day that is not a holiday.
